Women's Clothing

- 1 Long-sleeved solid color blouse
- 1 Ankle-length lightweight cotton skirt
- 1 Pair bloomers (lightweight capris, long shorts or hospital pants) under the skirt
- 1 Apron
- 1 Bonnet

Men's Clothing

- 1 Long-sleeved cotton button-down shirt, any color (not flannel)
- 1 Straw brim hat (no baseball or cowboy hats)
- 1 Vest or 1 Pair suspenders
- 1 Pair cotton pants, dockers style, khaki, black or blue Slacks and period clothing is strongly encouraged
